This week our Golden lunch nominees are:

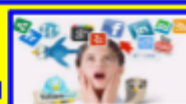
3R: Daniel O for his wonderful work on light with a fantastic scientific diagram.

Our learning..



This term our theme is Media Mayhem this term. This week in year 3 we have lots of exciting lessons planned

English: In English we will begin to edit our first drafts of our magazine articles all about the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb! Why not ask us about who found the tomb and what was found inside!

Maths: In maths, the children will be deepening their understanding of the 8x Tables and use multiplication facts to help them solve division as an inverse operation.

Science: We are continuing our topic of light. The children will be conducting an experiment to see how light reflects off different surfaces.

History: In History, we will be exploring the exciting theme of the Ancient Egyptians. We will be ordering historical events on a timeline.

RE: We will be looking at Diwali and what it means for different people. We will also be celebrating Inter Faith Week where children get to share and explore more about other faiths.

Shared Reading: We will be reading texts linked to our History Topic. The Texts are The Egyptian Cinderella and Tutankhamun. The children will build on their reading skills through questions set on these texts

RSHE: We will reflect on our coping skills. Children need to learn how to use their coping skills when they face challenging situations. The Happy Leaf will be given for Coping Skills and Independence which is linked to our RIGHTS.

DT: In DT we will be looking at our Big Question: How can I make, design and evaluate a moving Egyptian Pharaoh using levers and linkages?

P.E and Music is scheduled for Wednesday afternoon this week as normal, so remember to come dressed in your correct PE kit. If you are unsure, check the uniform policy on Star's newly designed website or ask your teacher.

Don't forget!

Children will be given weekly spellings to practise for 5 minutes each night. They will be tested on Fridays. We politely ask children to practice the strategies and extend themselves by using the words in a sentence so that they understand the meaning. There will also be a big focus on Reading. So, please do ensure that you read with your child daily and that you record their progress in the Reading record provided. Please continue to encourage your child to complete their tasks on our online learning platforms including Mathletics, Bug Club and Times Table Rockstars. P.E is on Wednesday - please wear your PE kit to school. Fit Friday is every Friday.

Home learning

Please remember to read every day with your child particularly over half term, this should be kept record of in their Reading Record Books. Children will be sent home with books and will be asked to keep them in their book bags which they can now bring to school daily. Children will also be given weekly spellings beginning next week.

By the end of all Year 3 children need to know their 2, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables fluently. So, please log in to Mathletics and TTRS to help you secure a Bronze Badge before the end of this academic year!
