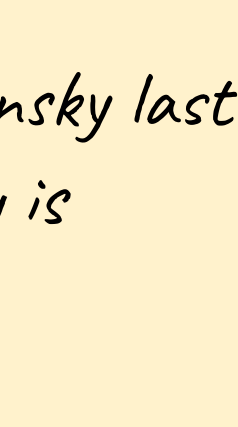


Weekly Newsletter - 10/11/23

Dear Parents and Carers,

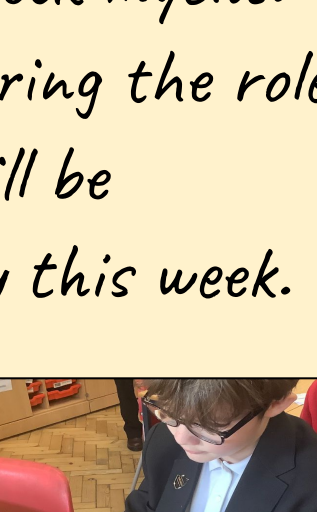

14 Year Six pupils have been working assignment at The Brilliant Club.

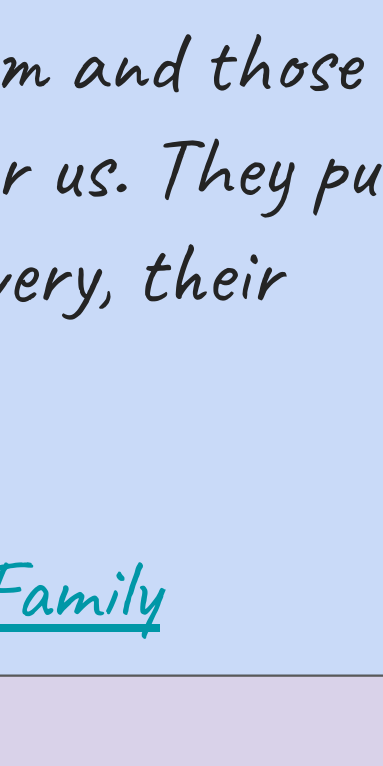

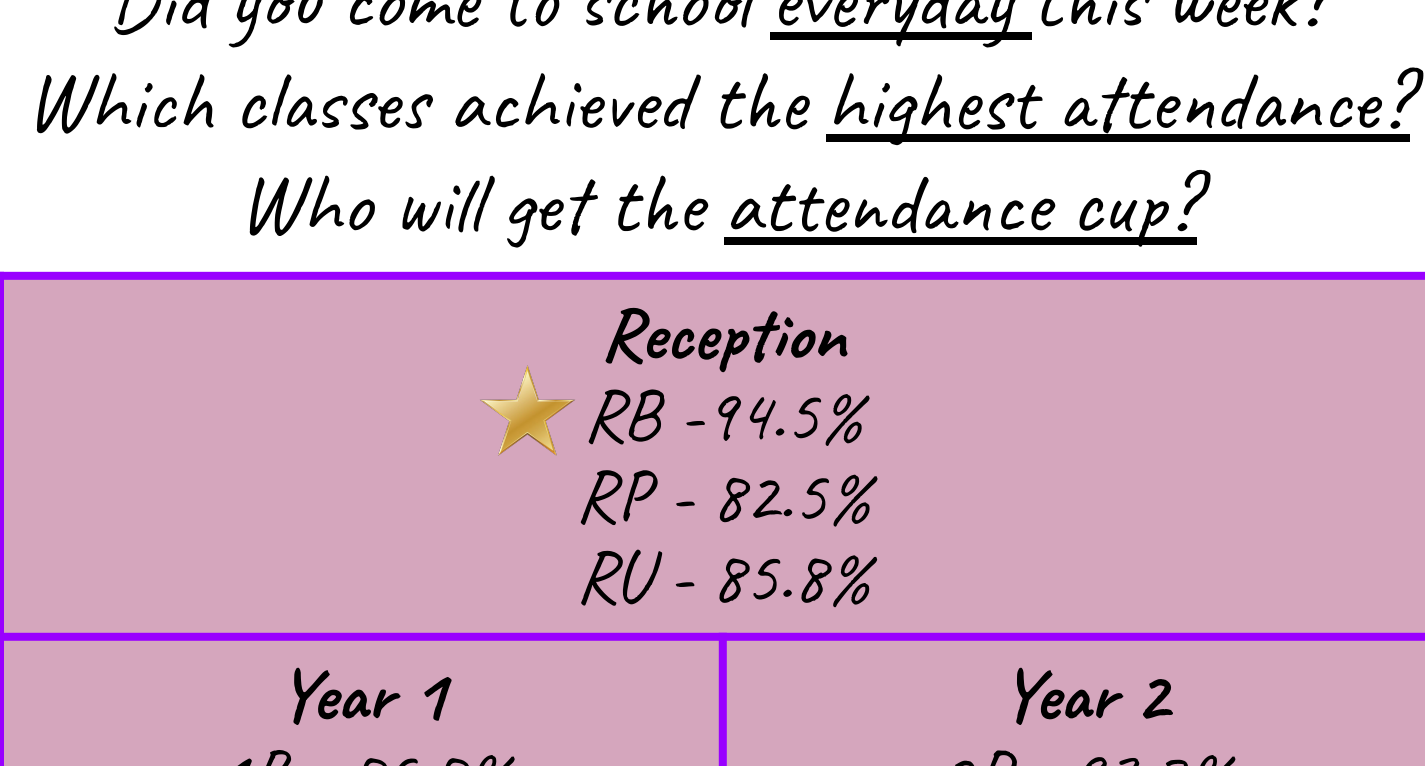
