We enjoyed singing the wartime song 'We'll meet again.'

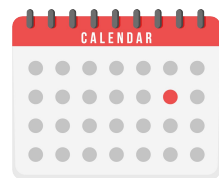


Year Four - Charity Event

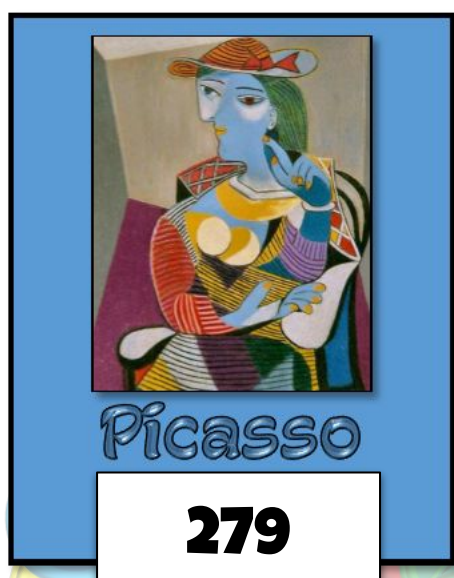

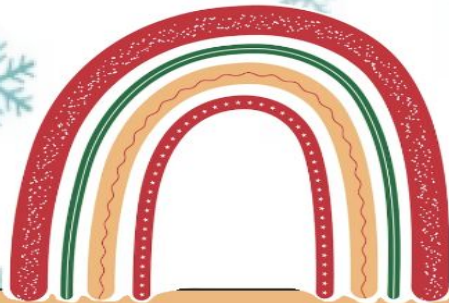

Our Learning

English:

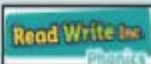
Over to you...Home learning

In Maths, we will recap all of our learning and complete our revision.



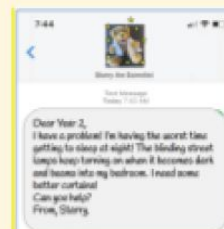
DT:

Our learning..



This term our theme is Media Mayhem. This week in year 3 we have lots of exciting lessons planned

English: We are now coming to the end of our English topic for this term. We will be practising sending emails and then we will be using our own school email addresses to send emails to each other as Howard Carter and Lord Carnarvon!

Maths: In Maths, the children will be multiplying a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number. They will be deepening their understanding by multiplying using renaming and place value. Thereafter they will solve division as the inverse operation.

Science: We are continuing our topic of light. The children will be conducting an experiment to see how sunglasses protect your eyes and which materials are best for them.

History: In History, we will be exploring the exciting theme of the Ancient Egyptians. We will be evaluating what we have learnt about the Ancient Egyptians.

RE: We will be learning about a Menorah and what it represents to Jewish people.

RSHE: We will reflect on our coping skills. Children need to learn how to use their coping skills when they face challenging situations. The Happy Leaf will be given for Coping Skills and Independence which is linked to our RIGHTS.

DT: In DT, we will be looking at our Big Question: How can I make, design and evaluate a moving Egyptian Pharaoh using levers and linkages? We will be creating a moveable puppet.

P.E and Music is scheduled for Wednesday afternoon this week as normal, so remember to come dressed in your correct PE kit. If you are unsure, check the uniform policy on Star's newly designed website or ask your teacher.

Don't forget!

Children will be given weekly spellings to practise for 5 minutes each night. They will be tested on Fridays. We politely ask children to practice the strategies and extend themselves by using the words in a sentence so that they understand the meaning. There will also be a big focus on Reading. So, please do ensure that you read with your child daily and that you record their progress in the Reading record provided. Please continue to encourage your child to complete their tasks on our online learning platforms including Mathletics, Bug Club and Times Table Rockstars. P.E is on Wednesday - please wear your PE kit to school. Fit Friday is every Friday.

Home learning

Please remember to read every day with your child particularly over half term, this should be kept record of in their Reading Record Books. Children will be sent home with books and will be asked to keep them in their book bags which they can now bring to school daily. Children will also be given weekly spellings beginning next week.

By the end of all Year 3 children need to know their 2, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables fluently. So, please log in to Mathletics and TTRS to help you secure a Bronze Badge before the end of this academic year!

Our topic this half term is...Media Mayhem

In Reading and Maths, we will continue revisiting our Mock SATs test papers to go over our answers and consolidate our learning.

In English and Computing, we will be recording and editing our VLOGs based on Ancient Greece.

In Science, we will be exploring how a switch works in circuit and making our own switch using a range of equipment.

In History, we will be exploring how modern-day life has been influenced by the Ancient Greeks.
