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
## Our highlights ...

Spring 1: Earth our Home



#### English:

As writers, we will be continuing our phonics journey using our Read Write Inc books. Children will be learning new sounds, reading and writing everyday.



#### Maths:

As mathematicians, we will be working with numbers up to 40. Sequencing them. Remember to log in at Mathletics as each child has some activities assigned.



#### RE;

Next week, we will be learning about the Sikh ceremony Amrit, why it is important for Sikh people and we will be able to identify what is needed for the ceremony.

#### Geography:

Pupils will be using simple observational skills to study the Geography of the school and its grounds. We are going to look at how human have affected the school environment by collecting data of the amount of littering around the school.

#### Computing:

This week we will be using sketches school to create digital posters about saving the animals and saving our planet.

## Over to you...Home learning

The teachers will continuously be providing online opportunities for reading, phonics and maths. We are checking who is logging on every week!



## **Earth Our Home**

We have lots of exciting lessons planned:

<u>English</u>: We will be delving deeper into deforestation. We will be embedding all our learning to write debate about deforestation


<u>Maths:</u> In Maths, we will be exploring volume as part of measurement. We will be reading scales and recording how much liquid a container has.

<u>Science</u>: In Science we will be exploring the functions of the flowers in plants. We will look at how plants spread their seeds.

<u>Geography</u>: We discussed Trade in the different centuries. We looked at Stone Age, the 17th Century and the 21st Century

RE: In RE we looked at the Torah and why it is a sacred book for Jewish people.

<u>Art</u> In Art we will be exploring what we know about symmetry and how we can use nature to create symmetrical patterns.



## Don't forget!


Children will be given weekly spellings to practise for 5 minutes each night. They will be tested on Fridays. We politely ask children to practice the strategies and extend themselves by using the words in a sentence so that they understand the meaning. There will also be a big focus on Reading. So, please do ensure that you read with your child daily and that you record their progress in the Reading record provided.Please continue to encourage your child to complete their tasks on our online learning platforms including Mathletics, Bug Club and Times Table Rockstars. P.E is on Wednesday - please wear your PE kit to school. Fit Friday is every Friday.

## Home learning

Please remember to read every day with your child particularly over half term, this should be kept record of in their Reading Record Books. Children will be sent home with books and will be asked to keep them in their book bags which they can now bring to school daily. Children will also be given weekly spellings beginning next week.
