On social media, it ca be easy to go down 'rabbit holes' that aren't beneficial to our welling. As platforms grapple with managing such 'legal but harmful' content, lives are being impacted - sometimes to tragic effect.

We might be daunted by the scale of tech giants and their content which so enthrals young people, but we can still help children to be aware of their mental wellness: recognising when something isn't ok...and knowing what to do about content that upsets them.


We are in the final week of the Spring term! What amazing learning and growth has taken place already in Reception this year! We are excited for the Summer term.


