Dear Parents and Carers.


Dear Nursery Parents and carers,

magic hair swap. We will be talking about our families and create lovely family pictures.








We will also be practising these Nursery rhymes: *Hello song* (feelings & Colours), Rolly polly, Wind the bobbin up, Bubble bubble pop.


We have been blown away with how beautifully the children have settled into school. Well done to all the children and thank you to all adults who have supported the children




